DIRECTIONS

Gwynns Falls / Leakin Park
Trail Head 2 – Winans Meadow
4500 Franklinton Rd
Baltimore, MD 21207

From the West and I-695 (Baltimore Beltway):

- Take I-695 Exit 16, I-70 East/Local Traffic/Park & Ride. Exit at I-70 Exit 94 Security Boulevard.
- Stay in the right lane and turn right at the Ingleside Avenue traffic light.
- Cross the bridge and turn right at the top of the bridge (just before the Franklinton sign).
- Proceed one block to the stop sign at Franklinton Road and turn left.
- Proceed on Franklinton Road approximately 1.5 miles past the intersection with Winans Way, and the Winans Meadow Trailhead will be around the bend on the left.
- Parking is available in paved lot, follow signs for event pavilion.

WHAT TO BRING

- Printed ticket confirmation
- Personal first aid kit
- Personal ID and medical information Rain gear or poncho (if weather predicts rain)
- Sunscreen and insect repellent
- Sturdy broken-in hiking boots or sneakers
- Comfortable clothing in layers
- A towel or plastic bag to remove your shoes for the trip home
- A leash for your dog, as required by park rules

THINGS TO KNOW

- Restrooms are onsite, equip with indoor plumbing and secure privacy.
- Eat a carbohydrate-rich breakfast before the hike and you may wish to bring your own favorite hiking food. A hearty lunch will be provided in Winans Meadow after hiking.
- Cell phone courtesy is leaving it on silent.
- Leave natural objects of beauty so others can experience a sense of discovery, the same as you have.
- "Pack it in-Pack it out". All left over food waste and litter must be packed out and taken back. No apple cores, banana peels or any other food or litter is to be left in the pavilion or on trails.

PICK A TRAIL

- Featured Hike**
Length: 1.5 miles
Time: 45 min-1 hr
Skill Level: Intermediate - Advanced
This hike has a little bit of everything! Featuring mostly natural terrain trails with a good mix of elevation gain and loss. There are a few paved sections and a great stretch of elevated planking through a wetlands area. Take in some history along the trail with the remnants of an old carriage bridge and stone water collection basin.
(Stream Trail > Old Spring Trail > Former Hutton Ave > Wetland Trail > Ravine Trail)
- Mini-Hike**
Length: ¾ mile
Time: 25 – 35 min.
Skill Level: Beginner
This is a perfect hike for children or people just looking to get a small dose of the backcountry experience. Meander through the woods and get a taste of classic hiking challenges. Experience will include short uphill and downhill sections, mostly natural terrain trails surrounded by a lush forest.
(Stream Trail > Ridge Trail > Ravine Trail)
- Toddler Trek**
Length: ¼ mile
Time: 10-20 min.
Skill Level: Suitable for walking / stroller use
This nature walk is great for our little ones who enjoy more exploring than actually walking. Mostly paved with a brief excursion into the forest on a natural terrain trail, passing by the historic "Old Waterwheel."
